A Homelessness Reduction Story

A City at a Crossroads (2020)

- Homelessness was a top concern for council and residents
- Limited resources dedicated to the issue
- PD and FD primarily responding reactively
- Mayor Barich proposed a Tiny Home Village (unfunded, logistical hurdles)
- A cross-department task force was formed



From Vision to Action

- Proposed Homekey motel conversion
- Secured grants and operator agreements (Shangri-La, Step Up on Second)
- Hired Homeless Solutions Coordinator

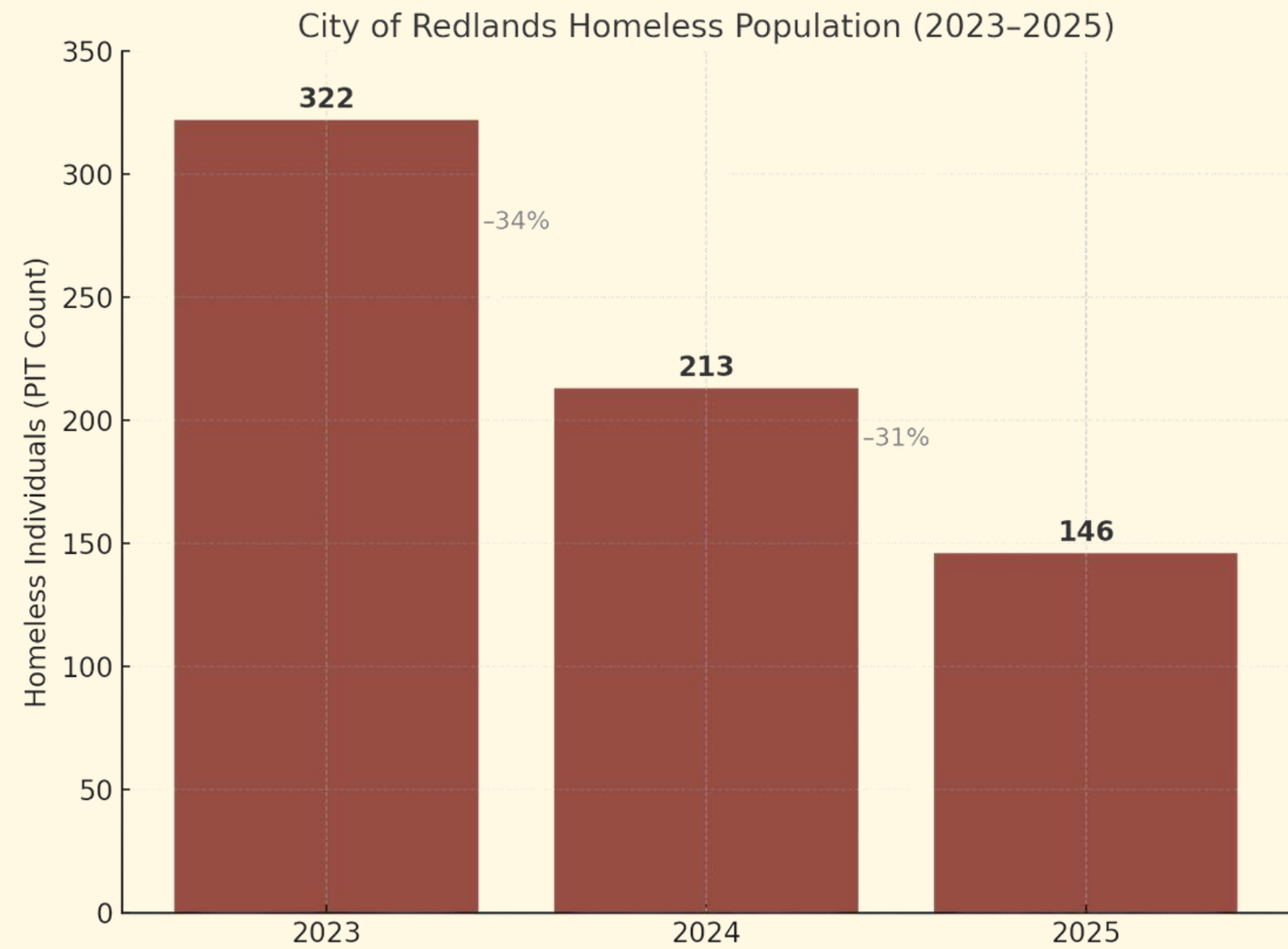


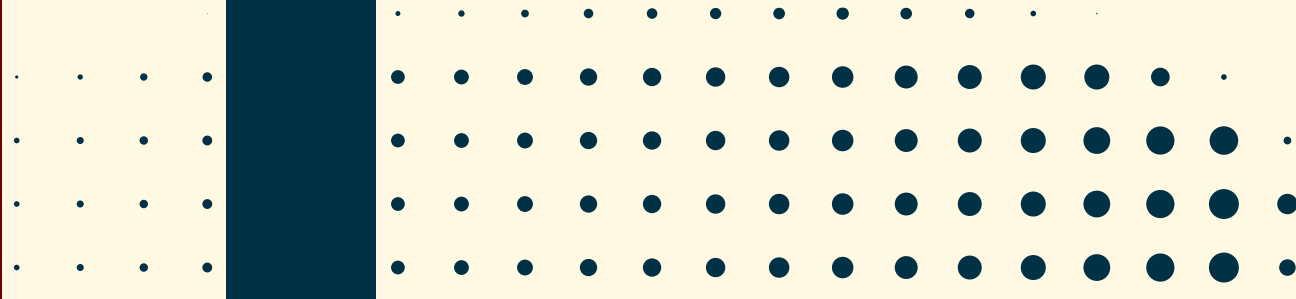
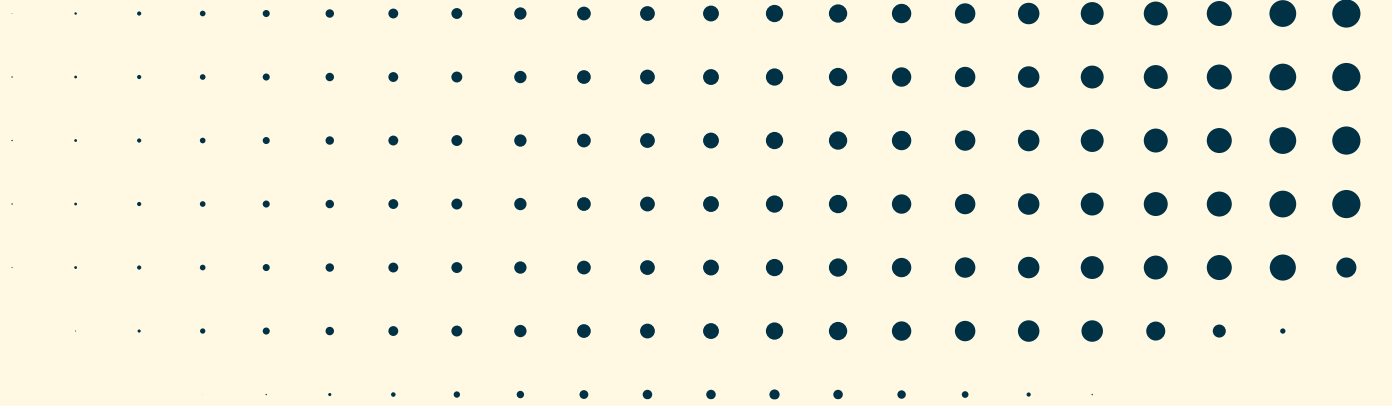
Turning Strategy into Support

- Lessons learned and looking ahead

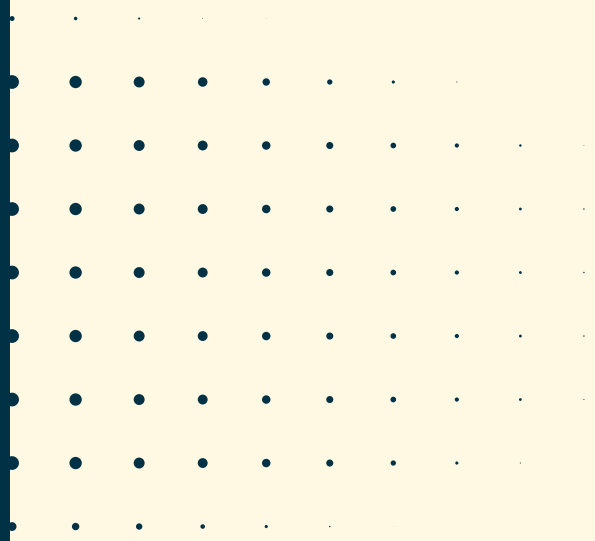
