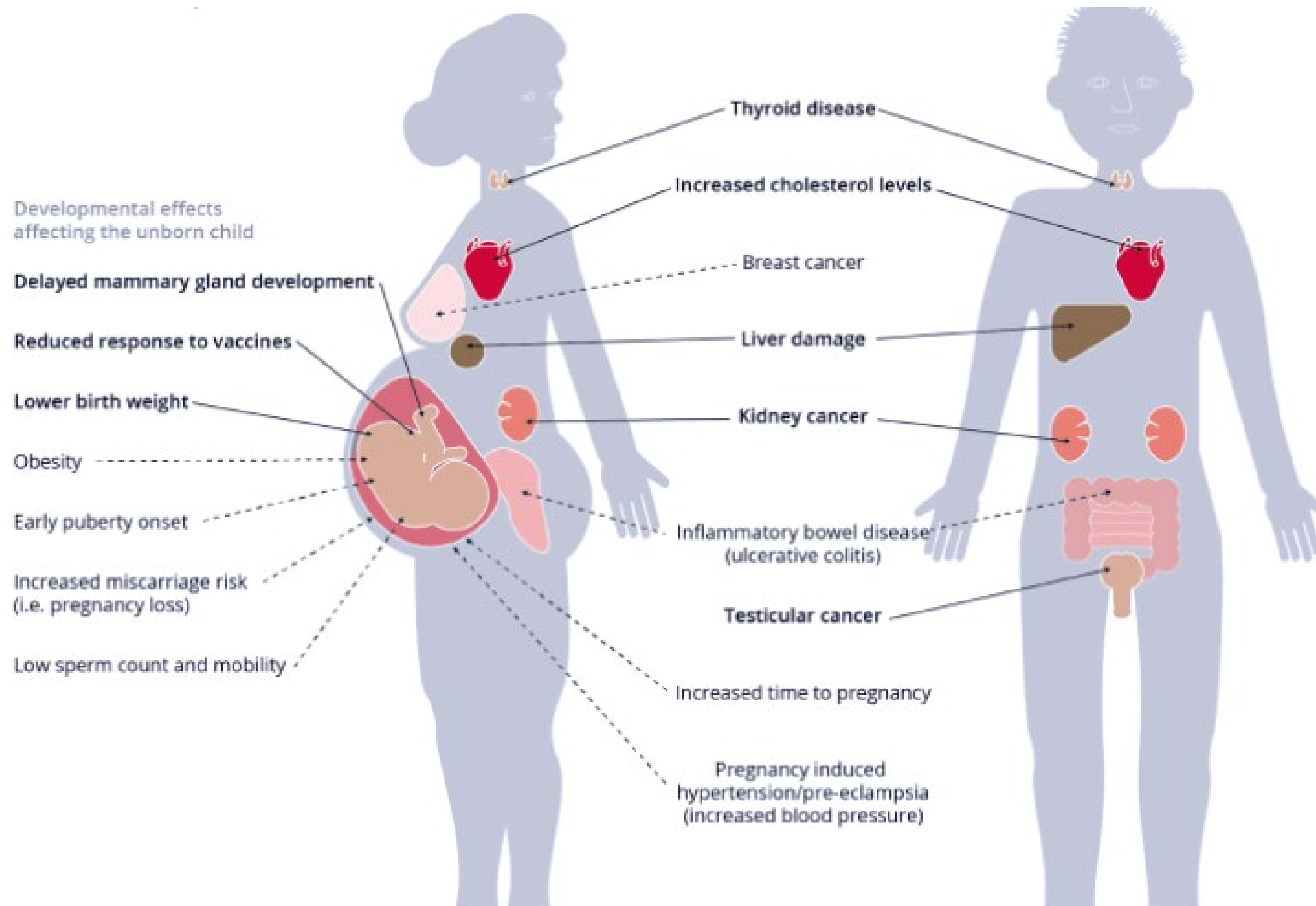

- Property Contamination- Airports, Firefighter Training Centers, Large Private/Public Landowners
- Personal Injury- Firefighters and Water Consumption



PUBLIC DRINKING WATER SYSTEMS



- Compliance with EPA standards
- Substantial capital improvement costs
- Costs of new filtration systems
- Future increased maintenance

- \$12 Billion
 - \$1.185 from Dupont and related companies
 - \$10.5 from 3M
- Phased payment schedules
- Funding for sampling and remediation
- Special Needs Funds

- PFAS detection before May 15, 2024
- \$1.06 Billion
 - \$750 million from Tyco
 - \$316 million from BASF
- Special Needs Fund

- Maximize Settlement Recovery



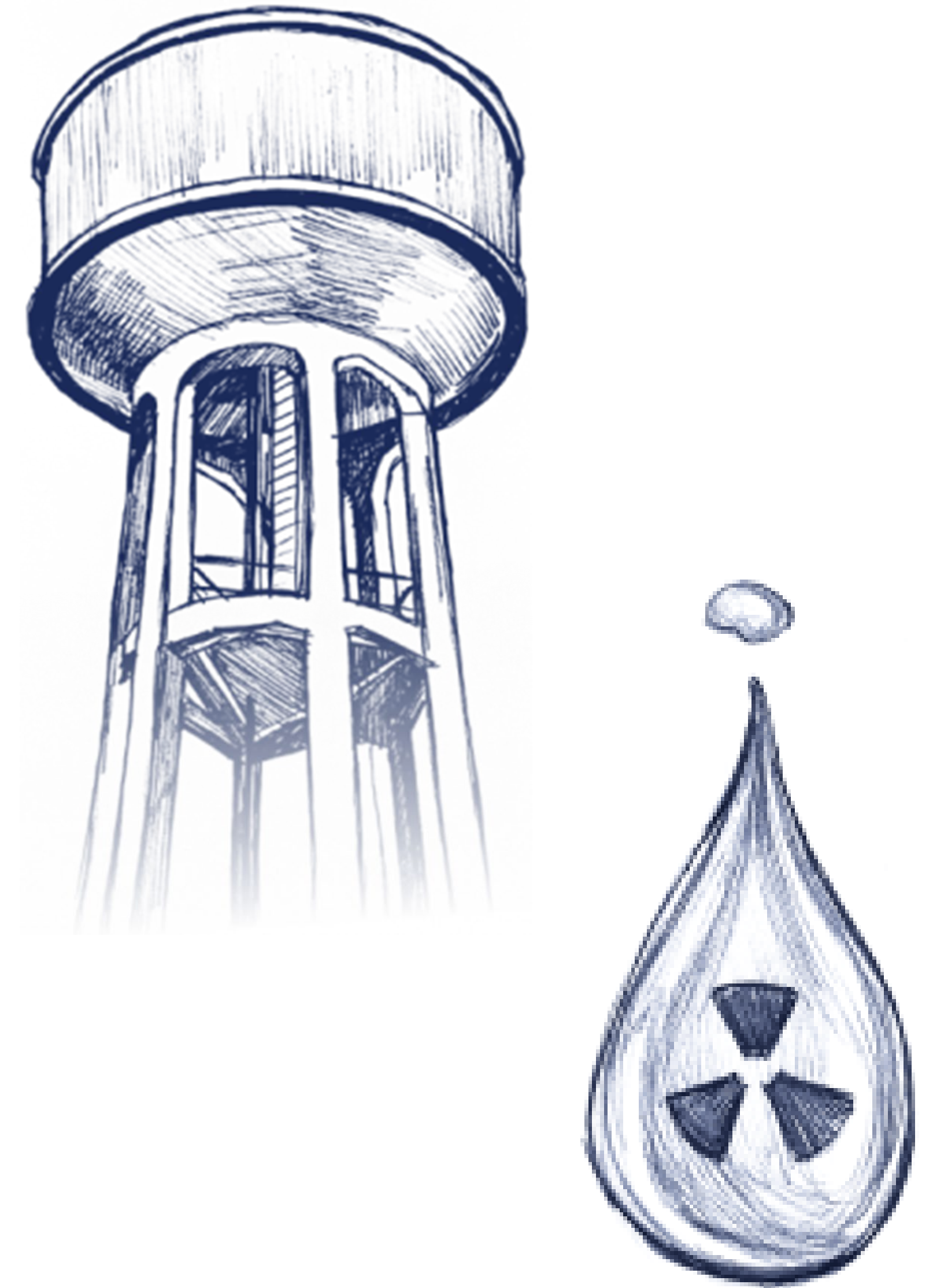
3M and DuPont - Phase 2 Deadlines

- *Baseline Testing- 7/1/2026*
- *Action Fund Claims Form-7/31/2026*
- *Special Needs Claims Form- 8/1/2026*
- *Supplemental Fund Claims Form- 12/31/2030*
