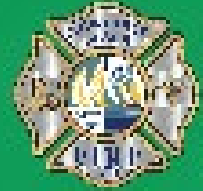

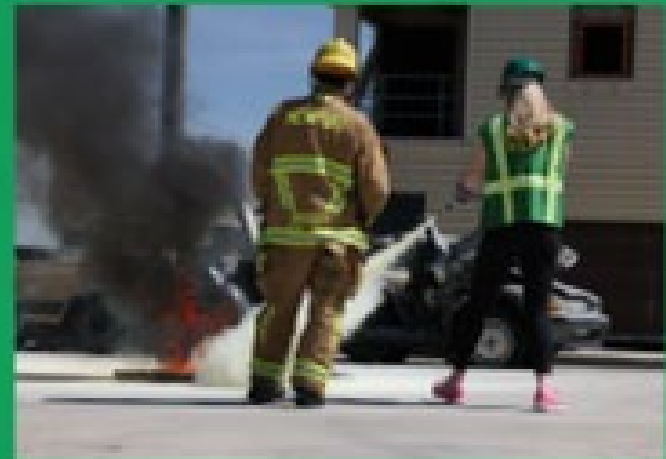

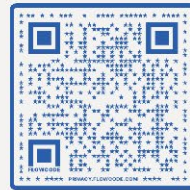


MAYOR'S YOUTH COUNCIL

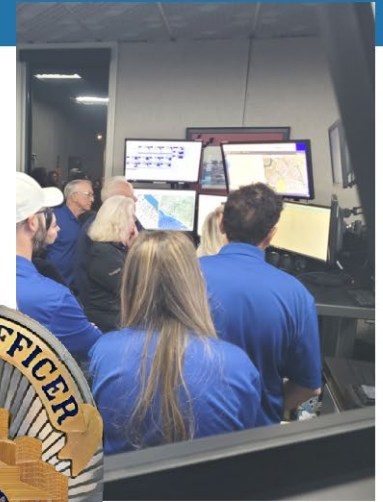
