State and Government Fleets State and Local Government Requirements 2024-2026 January 1, 2027 Designated 50 percent of Counties All additions additions to the fleet must be ZEV must be ZEV Agencies in designated counties exempt until 2027 Eligible for ZEV Milestone Schedule (new) May use exemptions and extensions

High Priority Fleets
State and Local Fleets

Optional ZEV Milestone Phase-in

- Meet ZEV milestones as a percent of total fleet
- Phase-in based on vehicle type
- May use exemptions and extensions

Zero-Emission Fleet Percentage	10%	25%	50%	75%	100%
Box trucks, vans, two-axle buses, yard trucks, light-duty package delivery vehicles	2025	2028	2031	2033	2035
Work trucks, day cab tractors, three-axle buses	2027	2030	2033	2036	2039
Sleeper cab tractors and specialty vehicles	2030	2033	2036	2039	2042

State and Local Government Requirements

Waste & Waster Water Fleet Delay

Facilities that collect and process diverted organic waste

Construction Based Delays

- Circumstances outside of fleet owner control
- Up to 2 years extension (extended one year)
- Information on granted extension posted online.

Electrification Delays

- Contract with utility executed one year prior to compliance date
- Extension approved for ZEV that can't be supported
- Would apply to power needs for charging
- Sunsets January 1, 2030
